KINDERGARTEN INFORMATION:

- Your child must be 5 years old by October 1, 2021 to attend Kindergarten in 2021-2022.
- Kindergarten registrations must be done by March 12, 2021.

PRESCHOOL INFORMATION:

Your child must be 4 years old by October 1, 2021 to attend Preschool in 2021-2022.

The Fairfield Board of Education provides an inclusive preschool program Monday to Friday from 12:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. The program consists of students from the community selected through a lottery system.

Transportation is not provided.

In order to receive a Preschool Lottery Application your child's information must be on our preschool list before December 15, 2020 ***(See above: E-mail information)**. This is a lottery system; not all who reply are selected. Applications received after the due date cannot be included in the lottery and may be put on a waiting list. Due to budget restrictions under S-701 a tuition cost of \$875 per quarter (\$3500 per year) has been assessed.

An important note:

Lists are kept for all children who will be attending the Fairfield School System, on an ongoing basis, to project class size. We depend on our parents to help us maintain these lists. By supplying the above information for your children from 1 month to 5 years of age, we can have information throughout the year helping us to prepare for future enrollments. If you know of neighbors with children who will attend the Fairfield Schools in the future, please inform them of this notice.
